

Photo Requirements

Your photo is a vital part of your visa application. To learn more, review the information below on how to provide a suitable photo.

Your identical photos must be:

- Colored
- The file format should be in JPEG (.jpg or .jpeg) and the file size should be equal to or less than 500 kB (kilobytes) (If it is less than 10 kB, it cannot be accepted)
- In a rectangular aspect ratio (height must be greater than width)
- The resolution should be in 800 (minimum-width) x 600 (minimum-height) pixels, with about 70-80% part of the photo must be filled by the applicant's face
- Taken within the last 6 months to reflect your **current** appearance
- Taken in front of a plain white or off-white background
- Taken in full-face view directly facing and looking at the camera
- With a neutral facial expression and both eyes open
- Taken in clothing that you normally wear on a daily basis (No uniform, except religious clothing worn everyday)
- Full face must be visible; no hat, no glasses, no hair should cover the face. (There is an exception for eye glasses in case of medical reasons.)



The proper picture is sharp, clear, and in a right position. Please pay good attention to the following examples;
